Course Bulletin – 4th November 2016

Ross McNeill has now completed the woodland thinning on all areas of the golf course. We are very grateful for the extent of the work he has carried out and the good humour and courtesy he has shown whilst he has been with us.

Drains are completed on holes 1, and 12. However, the drain on the 1st needs to be lowered – it is intended to address this when the contractor is on site in November. The turf on the 1st and turf & seeding on the 10th and 12th are complete. Sand will be applied to the new bunkers over January, February, depending upon the weather. This will allow us to ensure that the drains are operating efficiently prior to them being covered.

Ken Moodie, the course architect, has marked the bunkers and some of the mounding on holes 2, 11, 13, 14. Those who have played the course since his last visit will have seen the extent of these features. The hard landscaping work, starting **9**th **November**, will have much dependence on the weather. There will be thirteen days available, ending 25th November however, there is much to accomplish:

- 3 features on hole 2
- 5 features on hole 11
- 5 features on hole 13
- 8 features on hole 14

We intend to use 2 holes on the practice area whilst holes 13 and 14 are being re-modelled.

Some large areas of the course have been treated with spraying & strimming. We will develop a management programme to continue these activities long term. This will not impact the normal maintenance of the course.

The thinned areas which are in play will be seeded early in the spring.

- 11. Hard Landscaping of holes 2, 11, 13, 14 (starts 9th November)
- 12. Weed Control Program
- 13. Seeding of selected areas
- 14. Winter Program of Drains, Turfing, Seeding, Sand Delivery, Bunker Establishment
